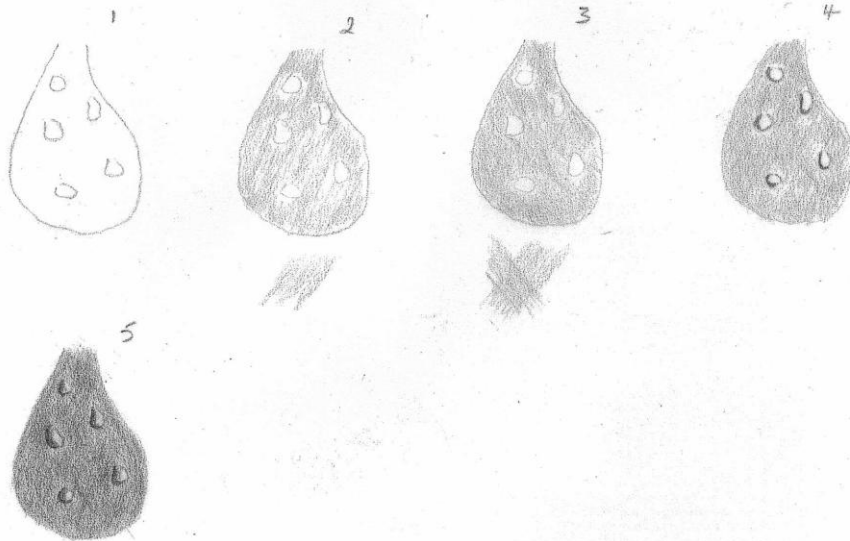
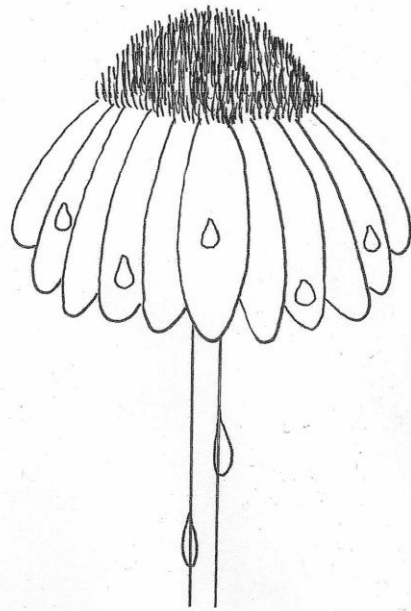


Easy guide to Drawing Raindrops



The diagrams above were created with a graphite pencil.

1. Draw an outline of any shape, then add a few small irregular shapes as shown. These will be raindrops
2. Lightly shade around raindrops using pencil in one direction.
3. Repeat shading but use pencil in opposite direction (cross hatch)
4. Darken the edge of each raindrop leaving an uncoloured area
5. Repeat shading of the shape until desired depth of colour. Keeping the darkened edge of the raindrop, a little shading can be added but be sure to leave an uncoloured area to give the effect of light.

Below are a few examples of raindrops in coloured pencil. Tear drops/water droplets are created in exactly the same way.
